Headstone inscription

To the beloved memory of  
Rev. James Edward Stead  
For 14 years  
Minister of this chapel 1891-1905  
Died Nov. 27<sup>th</sup> 1909  
aged 55 years  
also Emily his beloved wife  
who died July 24<sup>th</sup> 1927  
aged 72 years

Edmund (Eddie)  
the beloved nephew  
and adopted son of  
Emily and James Edward Stead  
Killed in action at Passchendaele  
Oct 9<sup>th</sup> (unclear) 1917 aged 19 years

Please note that Commonwealth War Graves states date of death  
as 5<sup>th</sup> October 1917. Soldiers Died in the Great War states that he  
was born in Middlesbrough and enlisted at Stalybridge.
